HOW TO PLAY THIS GAME:

- 1. No prep needed! You can play this game straight out of the box!
- 2. Divide students into 4-5 teams. I usually have the teams move desks so they can confer on
- 3. Keep score on a whiteboard (teacher or student volunteer), or ask one person on each team to keep track of the scores.
- 4. Team 1 picks a category and dollar amount. Click the question. If the team answers correctly, they "win" that dollar amount.
- 5. If Team 1 answers incorrectly, Team 2 will get a chance to "steal" the question. If Team 2 answers the question correctly, Team 2 wins that dollar amount and gets to choose another question.
- 6. If Team 2 answers incorrectly, the question is thrown out. Team 2
- 7. Continue to play until all the questions have been selected or class time is over. The team with the most money scored wins!
