


### **BOOK SPEED DATING**

- We will still have 10 minutes at the end to checkout from the rest of the library.





## LIBRARIAN INSTRUCTIONS

This activity takes a minimum of 40-45 minutes the first time your students do it.

This will get your students through the directions and 3-4 rotations + give them 10 minutes for checkout.

Once your students have completed the activity one time, they can do it again another day without having to spend time on directions. Once students understand the directions, they could easily do 5-6 rotations in 30 minutes.

- Timer--I use my phone, but there are also timer apps for PowerPoint online. You will need:
- Copies of the Book Speed Dating Record Sheets (pages 2-3). Each student should have his/her own record sheet. I have included front and back sides if you want students to use them again another day.
- PowerPoint or Google Slides presentation "Introduction to Book Speed Dating"—it's editable, so you can make changes as needed.
- Bins of 10-15 books on each table. I like to organize the tables and book bins by genre and allow students to choose their genres when they rotate tables.
- Pens, pencils, and/or colored pencils—I put an assortment in pencil holders (use upcycled soup cans!) on each table.

- Pull up the Introduction to Speed Dating presentation and project it on a screen. Go through the slides with the students and make sure everyone understands the instructions. (10 minutes)
