





## NO PREP NEEDED!

### HOW TO PLAY THIS GAME:



- No prep needed! You can play this game "straight out of the box"!
- Divide students into 4-5 teams. I usually have the teams move desks so they can confer on answers.
- Keep score on a whiteboard (teacher or student volunteer), or ask one person on each team to keep track of the scores.
- Team 1 picks a category and dollar amount. Click the question. If the team answers correctly, they "win" that dollar amount.
- 5. If Team 1 answers incorrectly, they lose the dollar amount.
- 6. Click "Back to Game Board" to return to the game board.
- 7. Team 2 choses the next question from the game board.
