# PLAY IN PPT OR GOOGLE SLIDES

This game is ready to click-and-go in either PowerPoint or Google Slides!

The two versions are exactly the same except for the way you mark questions as selected.



In PowerPoint, the dollar amounts automatically disappear when clicked. They will stay gone until you reset the game.



In Google Slides, use the pen tool to mark off dollar amounts as students play the game. Your marks will remain visible until you reset the game.

# ANIMATED GAME PLAY

This game includes features that ensure smooth game play:

- Students can see which questions have been selected already on the game board.
- Use the navigation buttons to play the game.

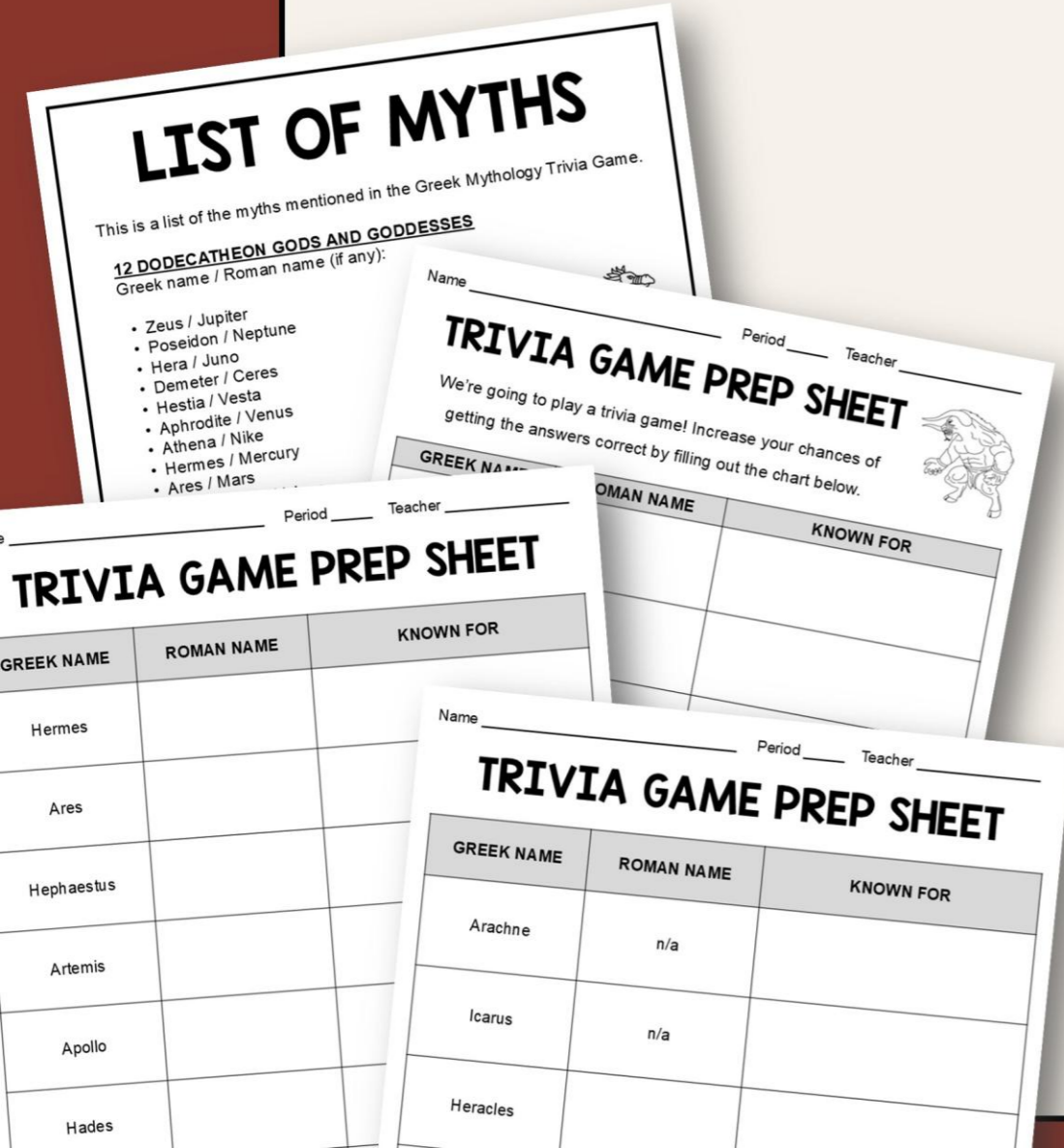
Press ESC to reset the game. This will clear all pen tool marks and PPT trigger animations

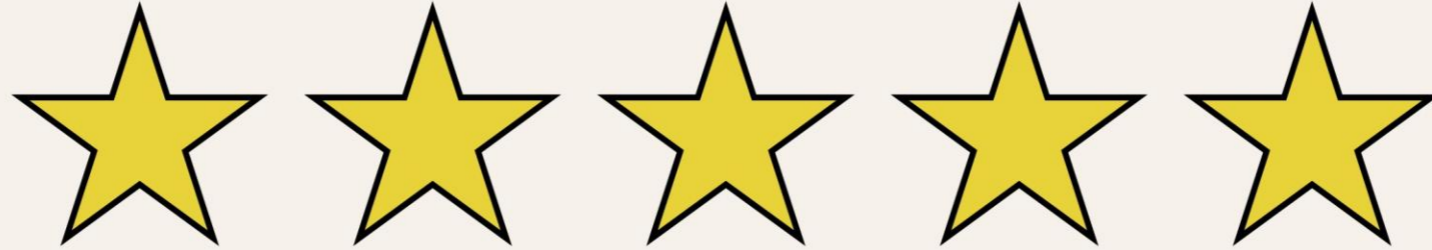
# PRE-GAME RESEARCH

Includes optional pre-game research sheets!

- BEFORE PLAYING THE GAME – In small groups or individually, students research the gods and goddesses that will appear in the trivia game. There are 22 gods/goddesses listed.
- Students present their research to the class so everyone can fill in the information on their prep sheets.
- When playing the game, students can use their research as a “cheat sheet.”

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## Is this game ready to use TODAY?

**YES!** This trivia game is ready to go, right out of the box. It's editable if needed, but this game requires no edits.

I recommend teachers practice clicking a few questions before game play. This will help you get a feel for the game navigation.

## What EXACTLY is editable?

### **Editable:**

All dollar amounts, question categories, questions, answers, and captions are all fully-editable.

### **Not editable:**

All images, game board design and title, and layouts/navigation buttons. These are locked to the slide and not editable.

## How long does this game take to play?

For my classes, regardless of grade level, it usually takes about 35-40 minutes to play.
