Read out loud to another person or a pet

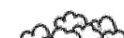


Read with a pillow



Read while drinking hot chocolate, tea, or lemonade

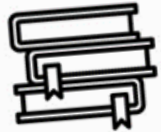

- Don't like reading? Try graphic newspapers, poetry books, short stories, and audiobooks!

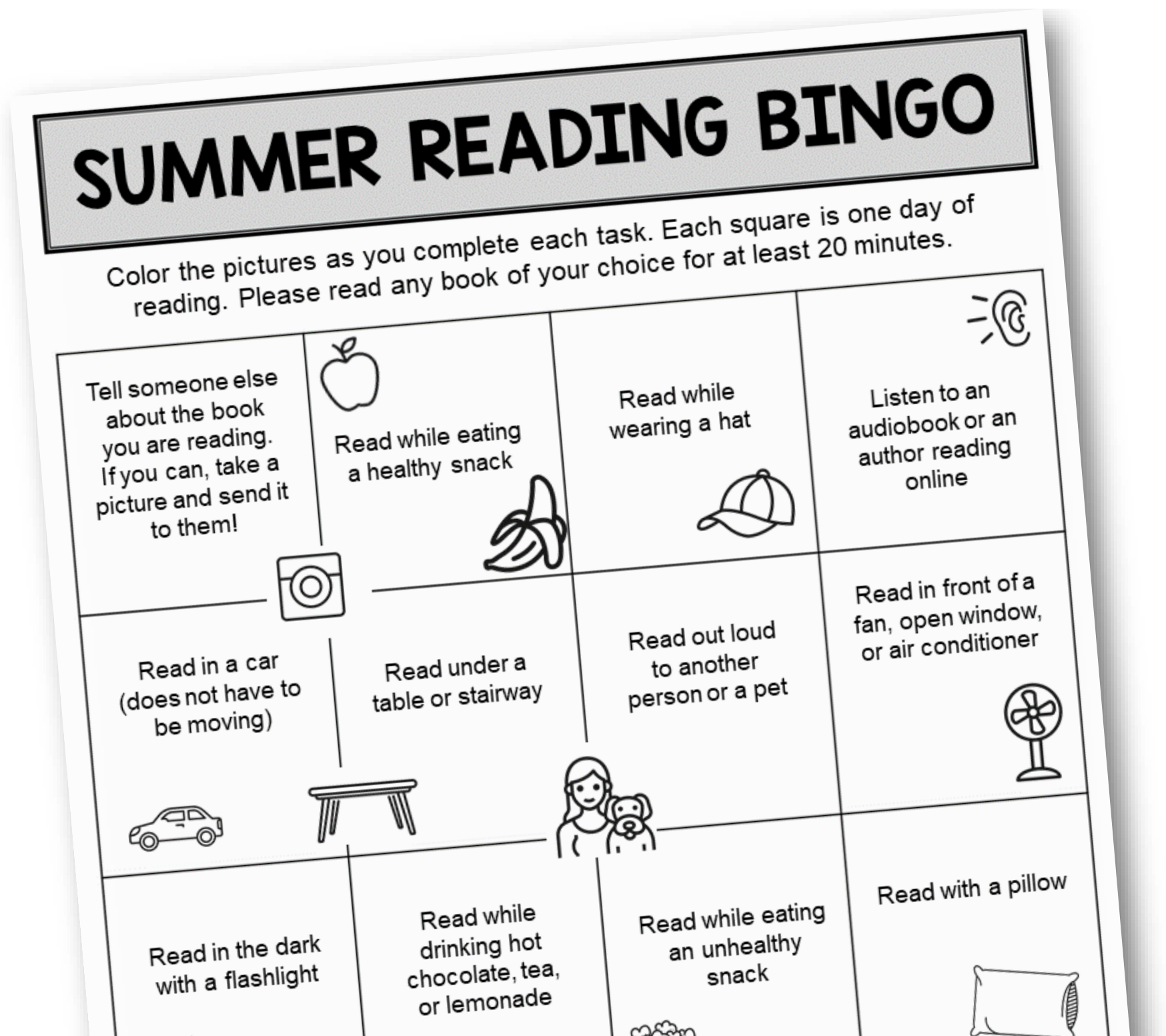
WHERE CAN WE GET BOOKS IN THE SUMMER?

- Project Gutenberg has thousands of free classic titles (digital only)

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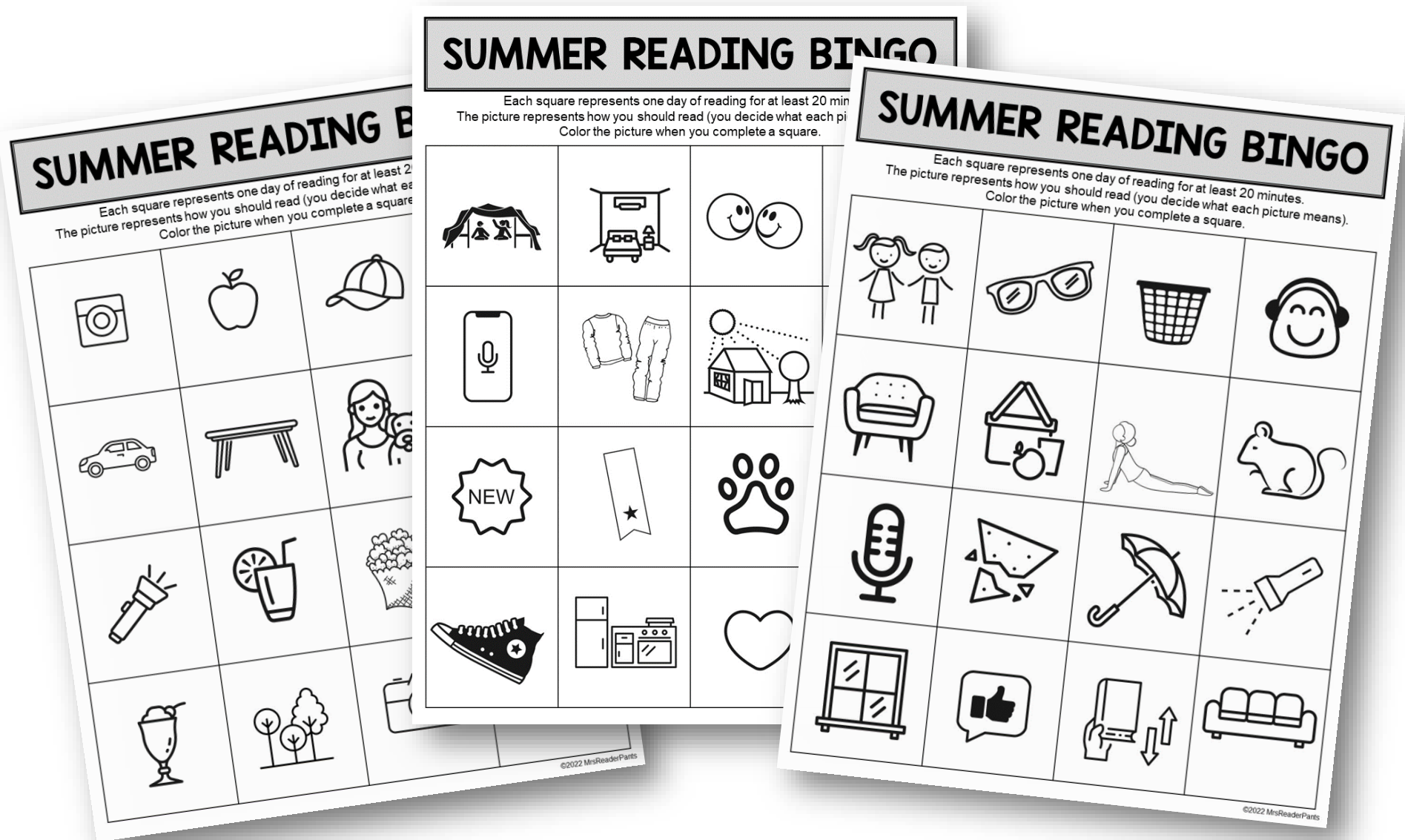

TEXT + IMAGES



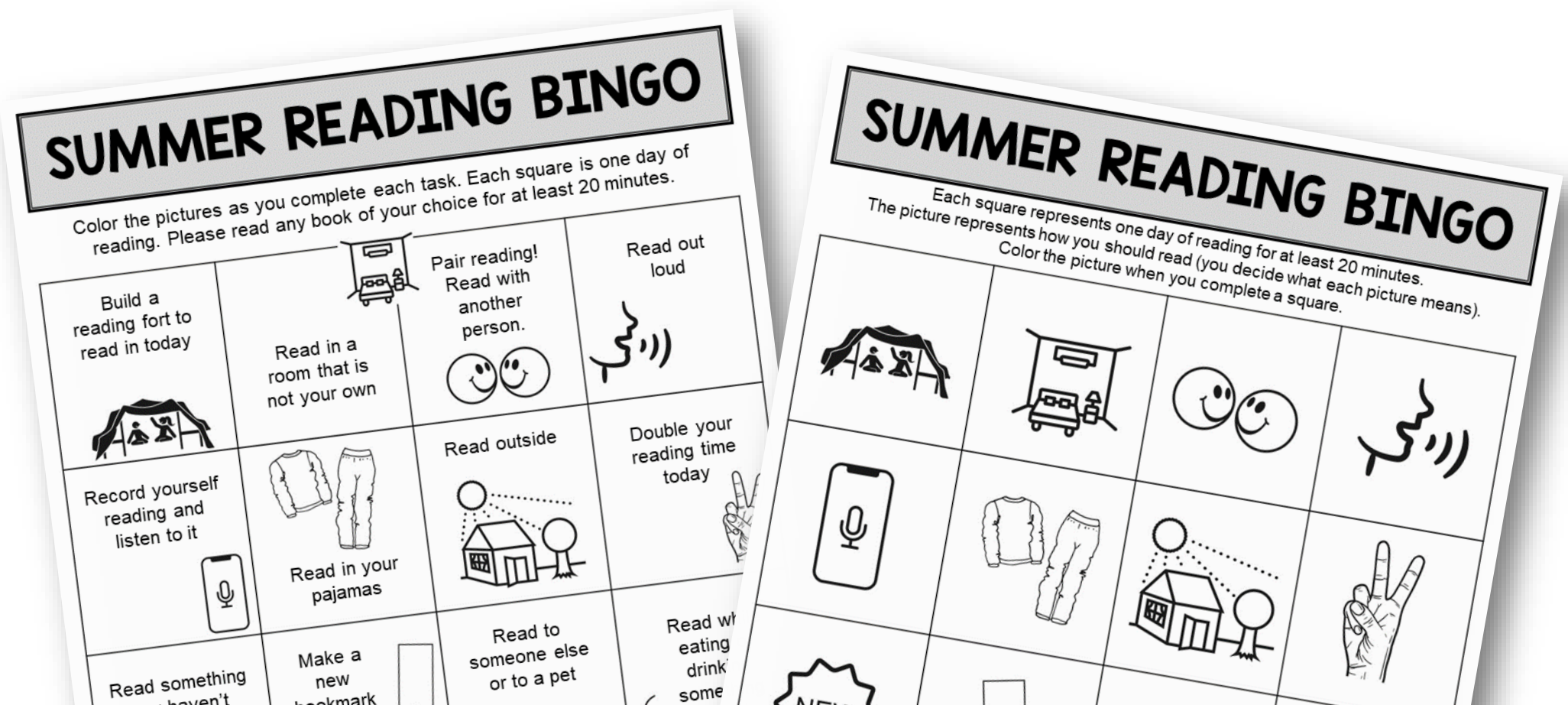
These are the same icons as on Version #1, but they have different written tasks for reading activities. Again, any books will work.

48 BINGO SQUARES



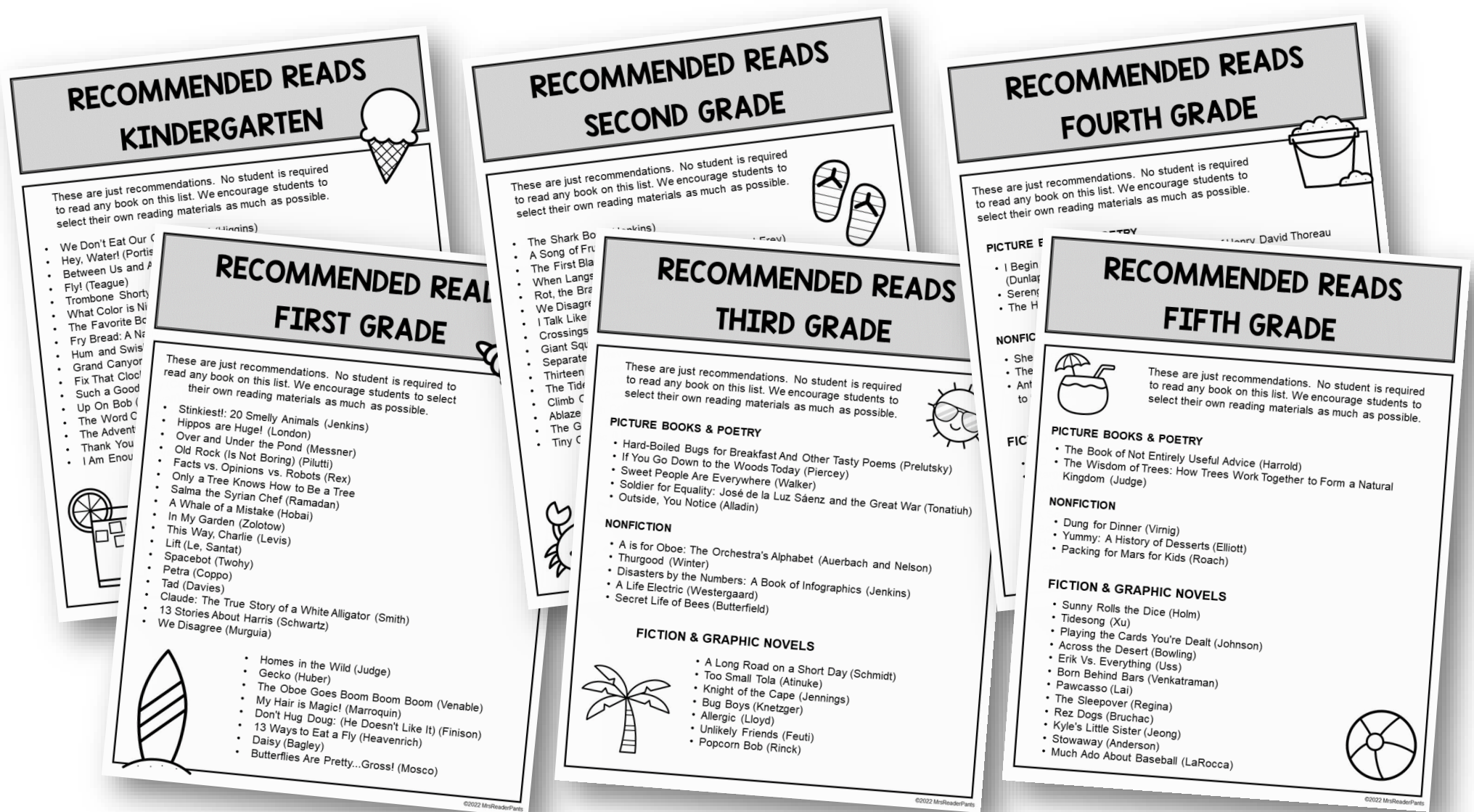
Version #1 and Version #2 each have 3 different Bingo cards with 16 squares each. That's 48 unique Summer Reading Bingo categories for each version.

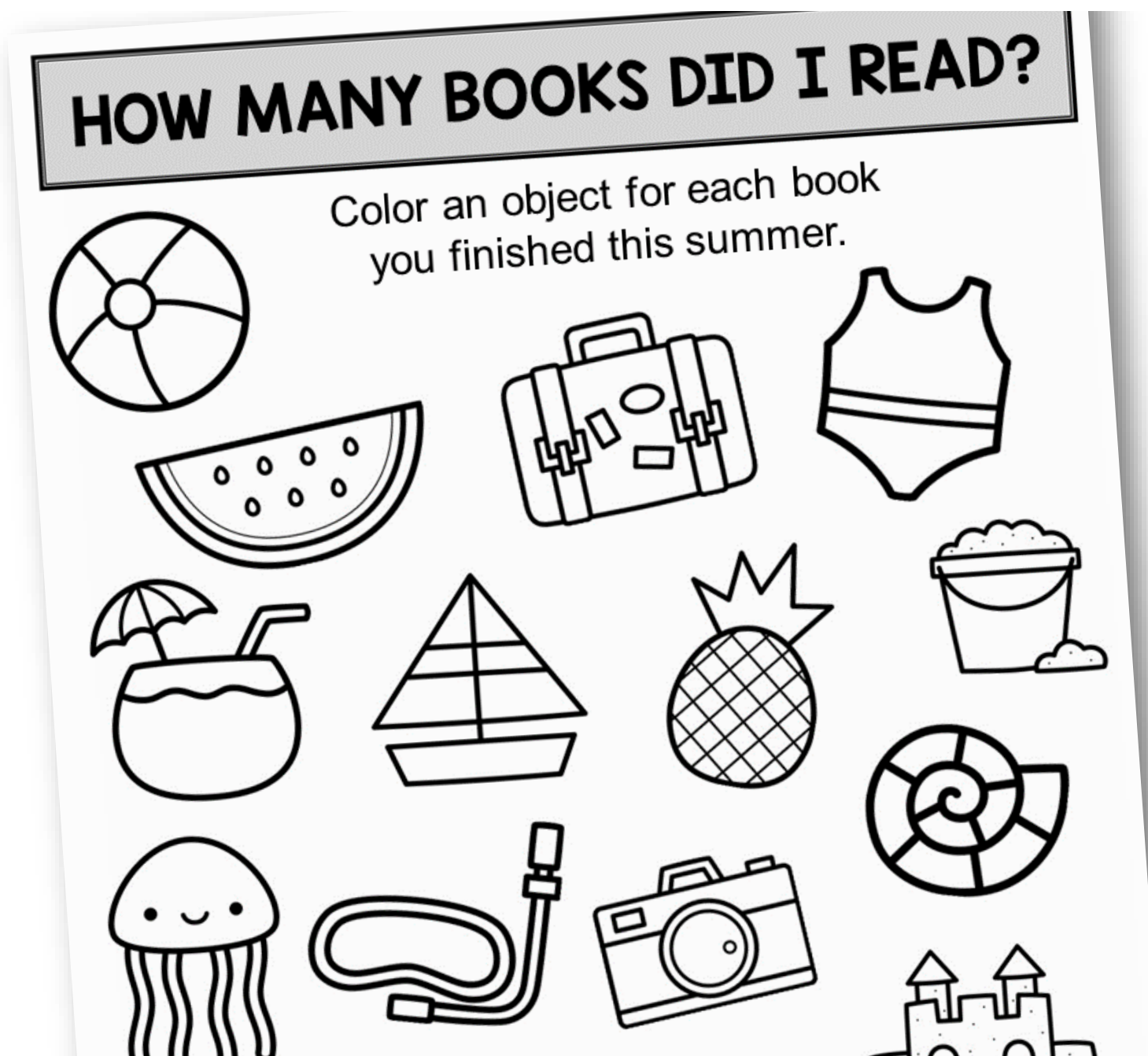
