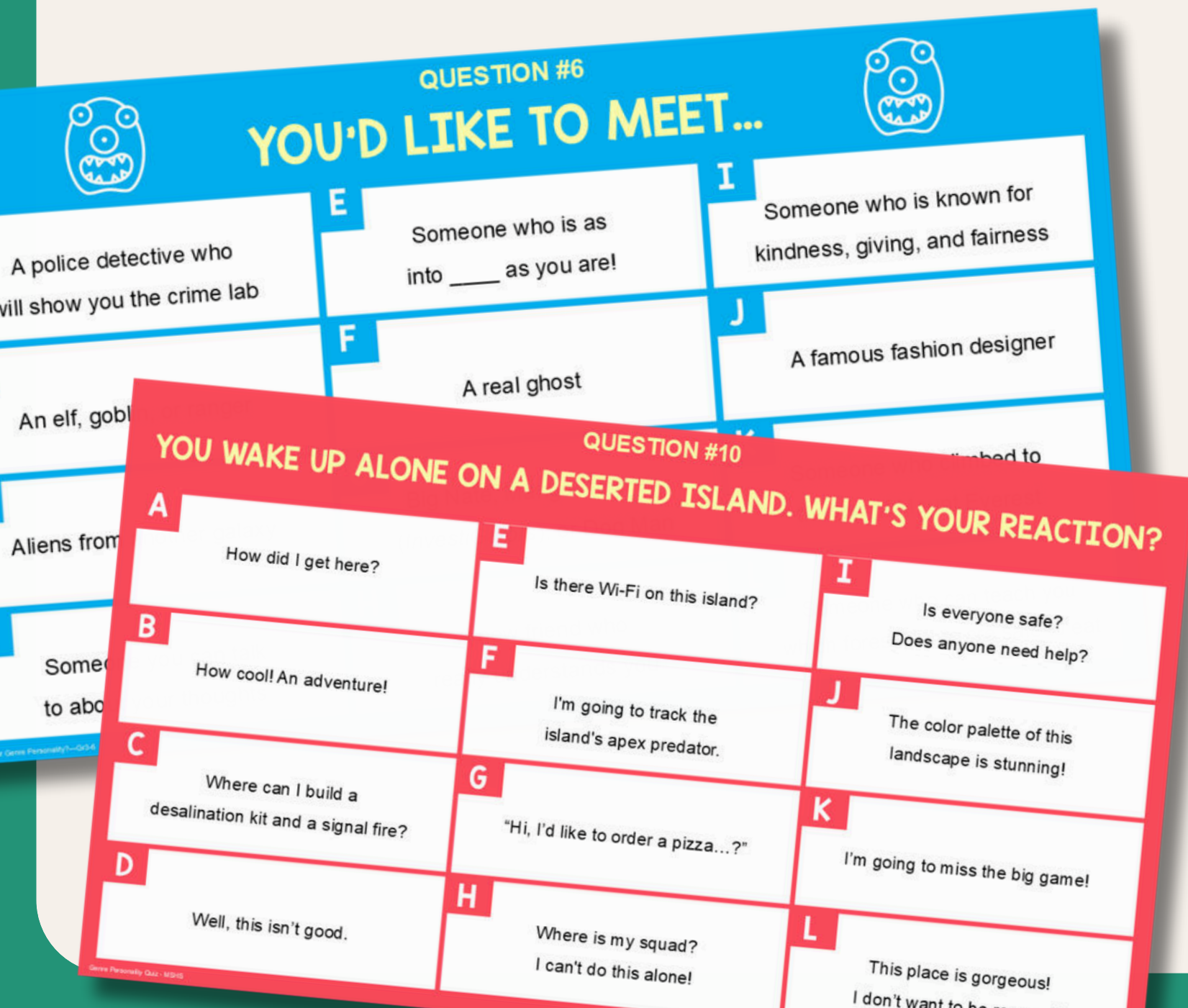

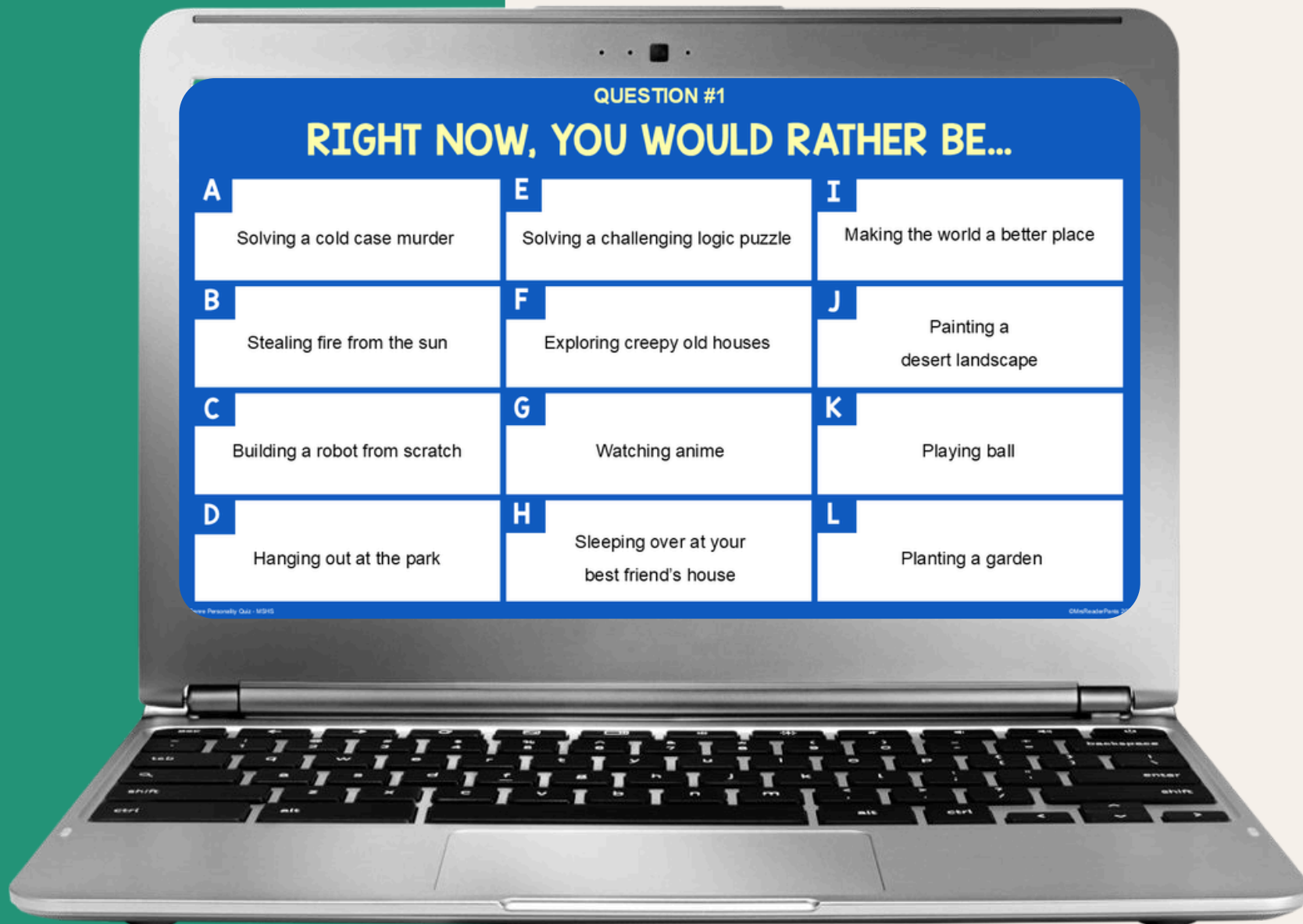

BEFORE THE FIRST LESSON

Stage	Estimated Time	Materials Needed	Quick Checklist
Prep Work	1-2 Weeks Prior	Promotion	Drum up excitement in the library! If needed, print the 4-page student quiz sheets front-to-back.
Lesson 1: The Quiz	35-45 Mins	Slide Deck, Tally Paper, Pencils	Read questions aloud. Let them talk to friends. Crucial: they write their answers and collect them at the end so they don't lose them.
Lesson 2: Profiles	35-45 Mins	Completed Quizzes, Bookmarks, Profile Cards	Let students write their final letters through their personalities. Hand matching and carry them to the end.

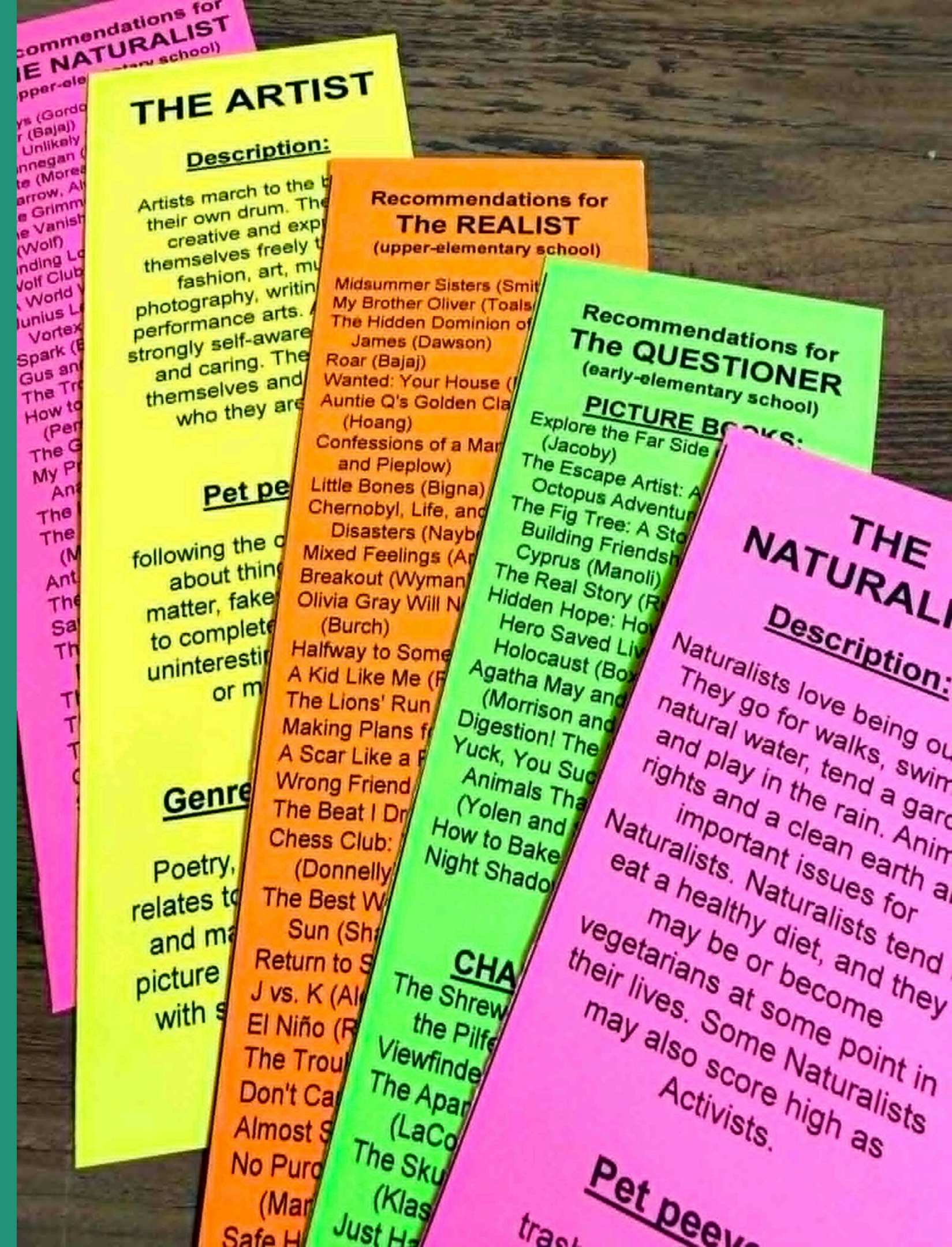
KEEP THE EXCITEMENT GOING!

Besties have high levels of social intelligence. They can tell when someone they care about is feeling down, even when others don't seem to notice. Besties make great friends because they pay attention to how other people feel. The best books for Besties focus on relationships between friends and family.

Pet peeves: Not understanding why someone "acts like that"; feeling like they are about to cry in front of people; secrets between friends

Genres for Besties: realistic fiction, school stories, diaries and journals, classics, books that focus on relationships
