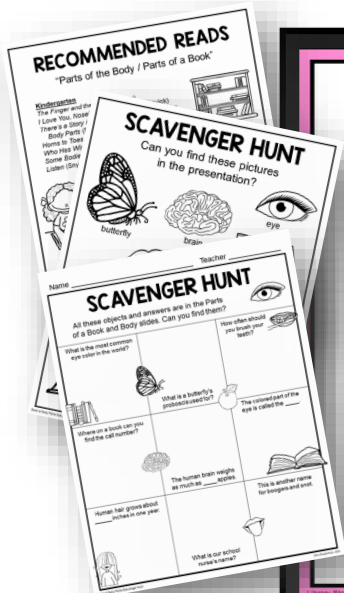
# STORYTIME

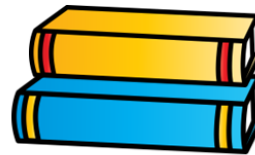

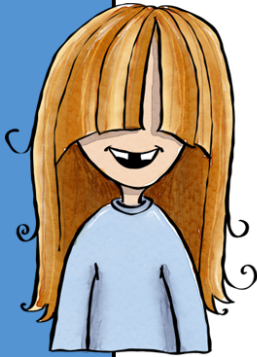

# PART I - WHOLE CLASS LESSON

## FRONT COVER

The front cover is like a book's face.

Our faces are often the first things we see when we meet someone.

They help us tell who is who (and which book is which).



## BACK COVER

The back cover is like your back.

It helps close up your body so your parts don't fall out on the back side!

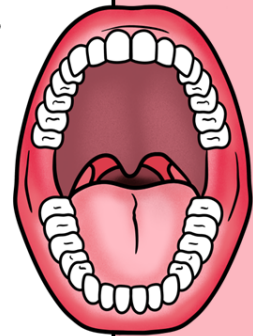

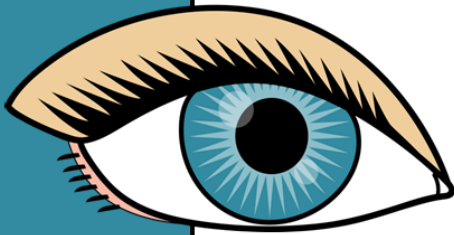

## BOOGERS AND SNOT!

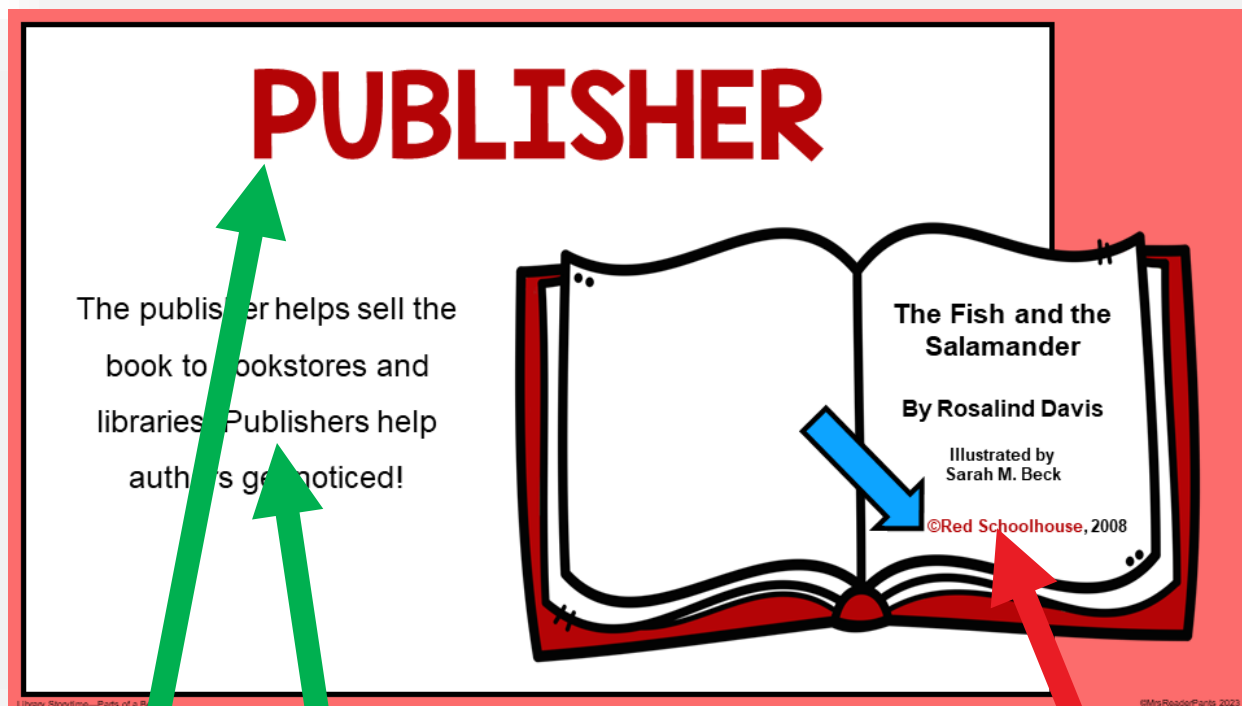
Boogers and snot are called mucus.

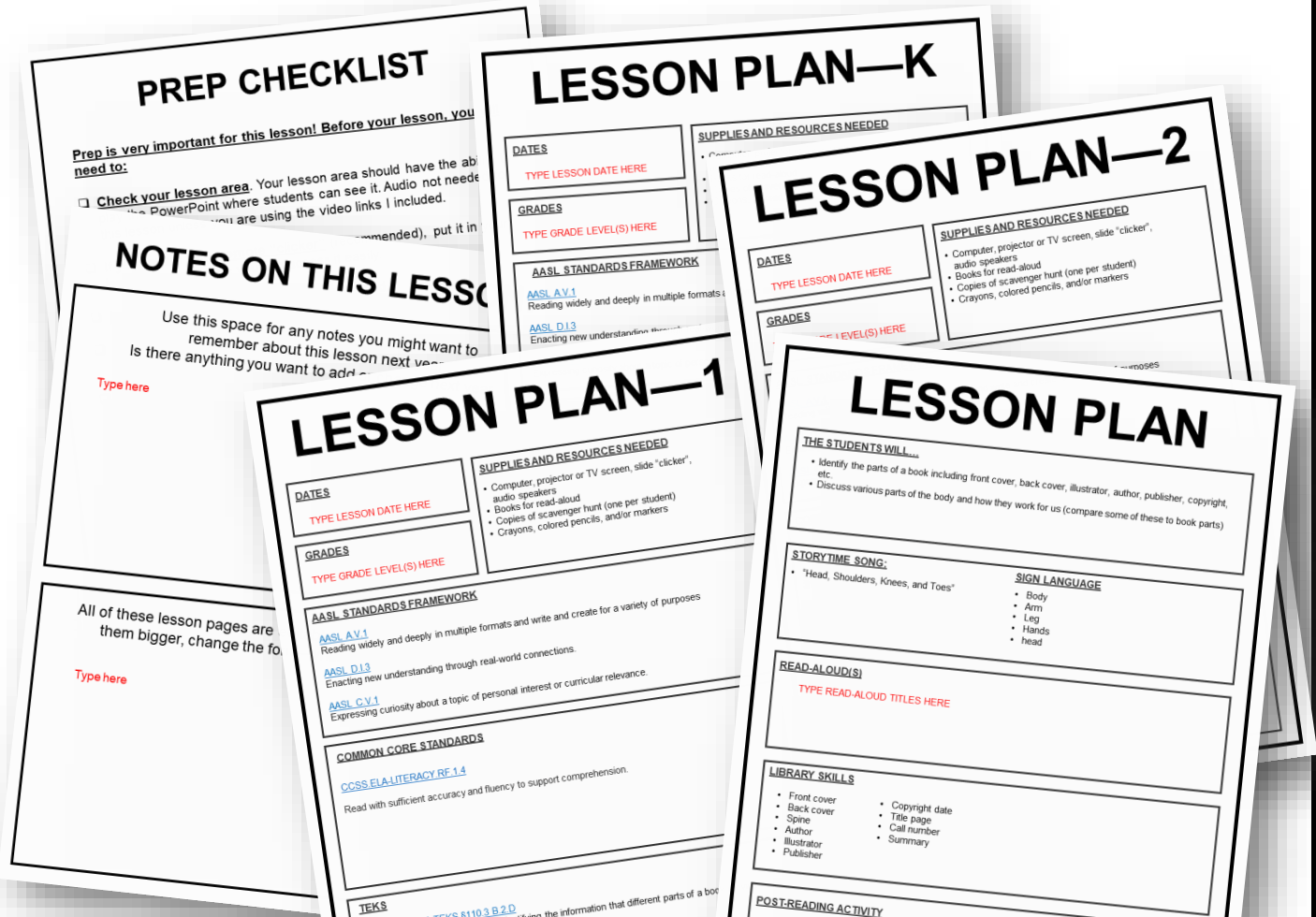
