Arachne was a brilliant weaver.

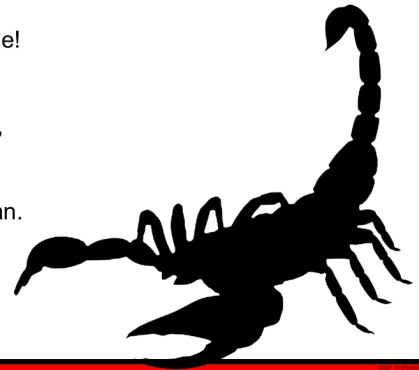
She was so proud of her skill! Arachne boasted she could weave even better than the goddess Athena.

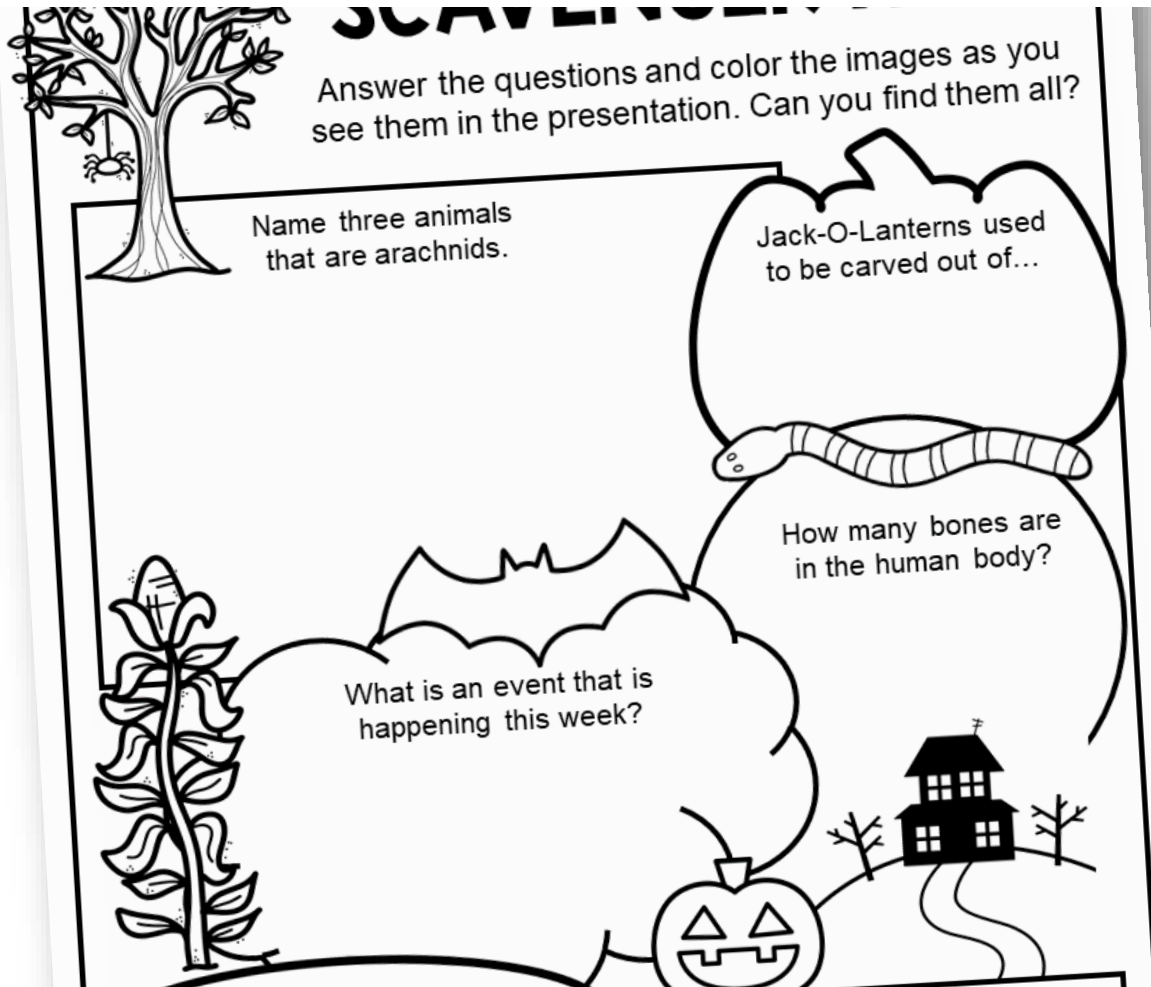

Eclipses happen a few times a year. They happen when the sun, moon, and earth line up and block each other's light. There are two types of eclipses: solar and lunar.


