The Printz Award is limited to four Honor books, but the Sibert does not restrict the number of Honor books.

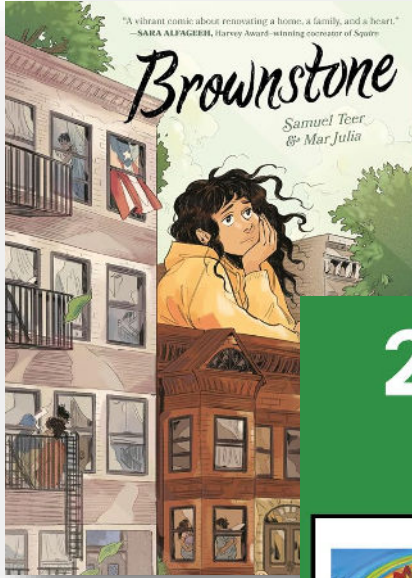

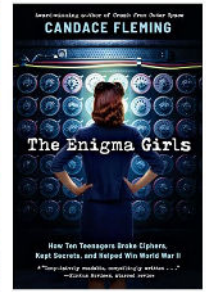
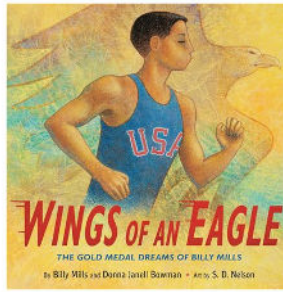
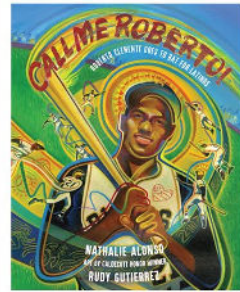
2025 PRINTZ WINNER

BELPRE CRITERIA

To be eligible for the Pura Belpré Award, books must be:

- written or illustrated by a Latinx author or illustrator
- a book that portrays, affirms, and celebrates the Latinx cultural experience
- Published in the USA or Puerto Rico
- published in the previous year
- written for children or teens (age 0-18)
- Fiction or nonfiction
- Published in Spanish, English, or bilingual

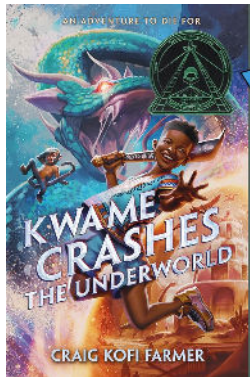

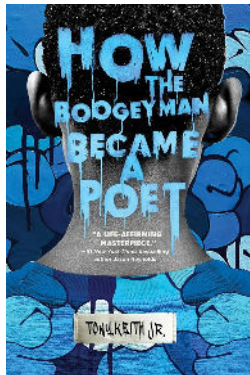
JOHN STEPTOE AWARD

You might also see books with a green and black seal on the cover. This seal looks similar to the Coretta Scott King Award seal.

The green and black seal is for the John Steptoe Award. This award is part of the Coretta Scott King Awards, but it is given for new talent.

There are two John Steptoe winners each year. One is for authors, and one is for illustrators.

2025 ODYSSEY AWARD WINNER

How the Boogeyman Became a Poet is the 2025 Odyssey Award winner for young adult books.

This book is a memoir told in verse (poetry) format.

The author, Tony Keith, Jr. is the main character of the story. The book is based on the author's own experiences with identity, family and societal expectations, and closeted sexuality.

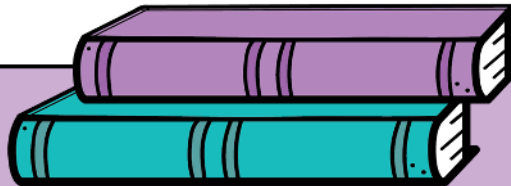
SIBERT AWARD

The **Sibert Award** for informational books was first awarded in 2001.

The Sibert Award also has one winner and a few honor books.

Robert F. Sibert established the Association for Library Service to Children (ALSC).

He was also the president of Bound to Stay Bound Books for many years.
