restrict the number of Honor books.





## BELPRE CRITERIA



To be eligible for the Pura Belpré Award, books must be:

- written or illustrated by a Latinx author or illustrator
- a book that portrays, affirms, and celebrates the Latinx cultural experience
- Published in the USA or Puerto Rico
- published in the previous year
- written for children or teens (age 0-18)
- Fiction or nonfiction
- Published in Spanish, English, or bilingual





2024 PURA BELPRE WINNER - YA

Max and Jay have always depended on one another for their survival.

Growing up with a physically abusive father, the two Bribe American brothers have learned that the only way to protect themselves and their mother is to stick to a schedule and keep their heads down.

But when they hear a classmate in trouble in the woods, instinct takes over and they intervene, breaking up a fight and beating their high school's star soccer player to a pulp.

This act of violence threatens the brothers' dreams for the future and their beliefs about who they are.

# SCROLLING SLIDES

## SIBERT CRITERIA

To be eligible for the Sibert Award, books must be:

- informational
- published in the United States
- written by a U.S. resident
- first published in the year of the award

Additionally:

- Authors
- Not eligible for the award




## SIBERT AWARD

The **Sibert Award** for informational books was first awarded in 2001.

The Sibert Award also has one winner and a few honor books.

Robert F. Sibert established the Association for Library Service to Children (ALSC).

He was also the president of Bound to Stay Bound Books for many years.
