

This helps ensure smooth game play.


Students cannot pick the same question twice.

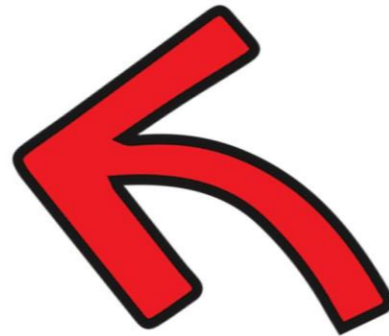
