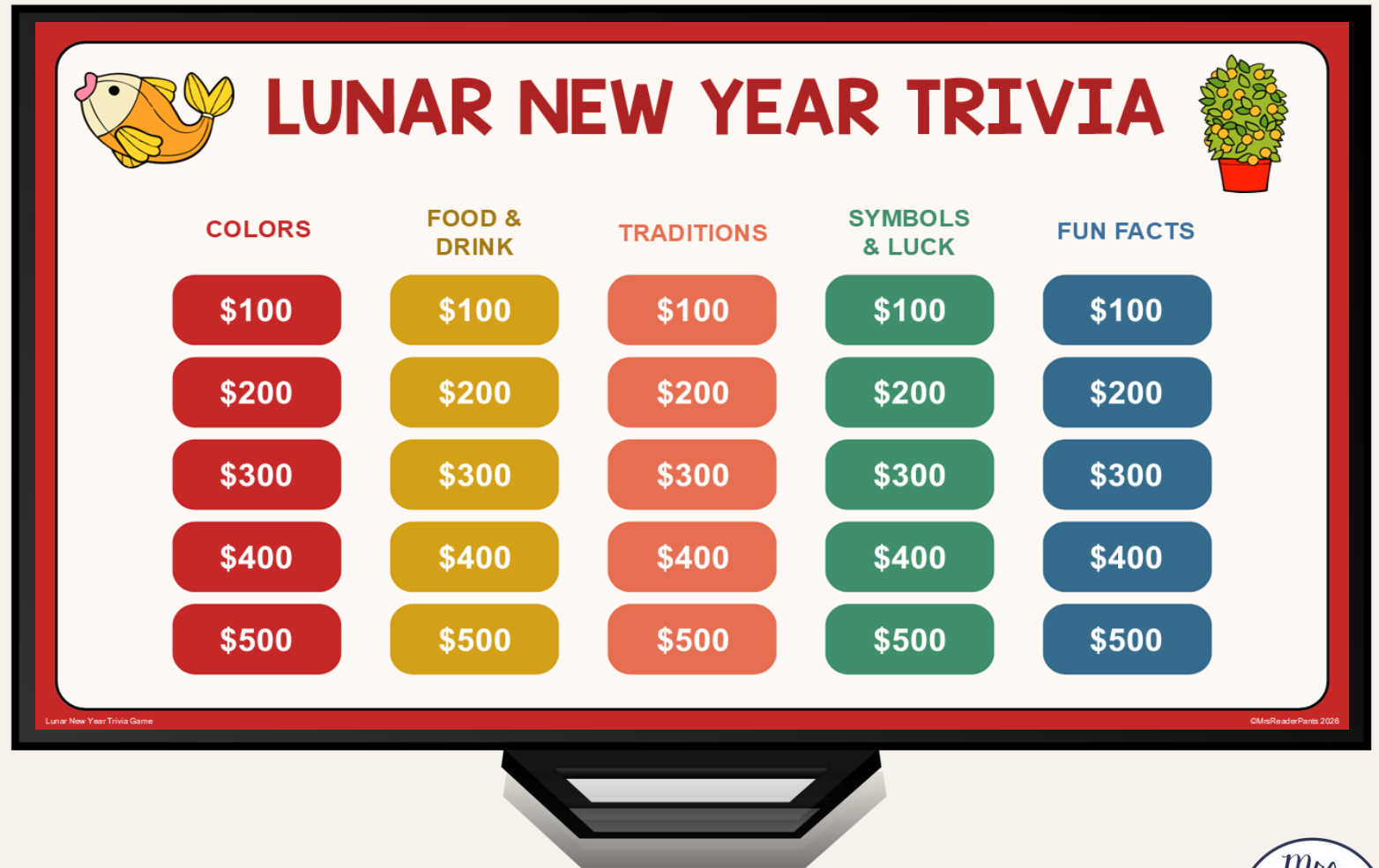

Gameplay: In PowerPoint, dollar amounts disappear when clicked. A green arrow points to the \$200 prize in the COLORS column, and a red arrow points to the \$400 prize in the FUN FACTS column.

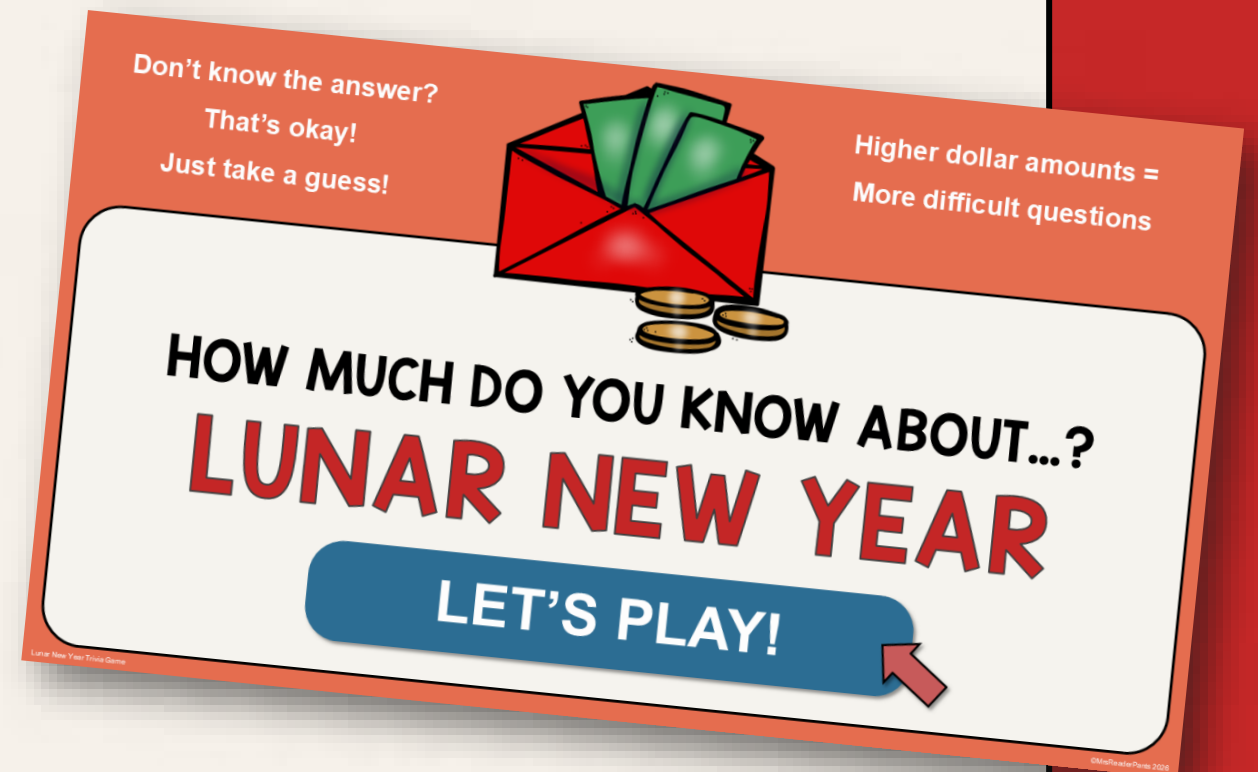
Game Instructions

ANIMATED GAMEPLAY

This game includes features that ensure **smooth gameplay**:

- Students can see which questions have been selected already on the game board.
- Use the navigation buttons to play the game.

Press ESC to **reset the game**. This will clear all pen tool marks and PowerPoint trigger animations.



ACCESSIBILITY FEATURES

SYMBOLS & LUCK - \$100

This cat is called a *maneki-neko*. You may have seen it at the entrance of Chinese or Japanese restaurants. What is it doing with its paw?

- A. Waving to customers
- B. Swatting flies
- C. Keeping itself cool

A. Waving to customers

Maneki-neko originated in Japan, but they can be seen in many Asian-owned businesses around the world.

The cat is usually white, black, gold, orange, and/or red in color.

BACK TO GAME BOARD
