 Free and compulsory from age 6-13, but in reality, lots of rural children do not attend school

 About 80% of children age 6-13 attend school

 Secondary school attendance (age 14+) is only about 25% of all students

 Mostly public schools, but private schools exist

 Quality of education varies widely rural schools are lower quality than urban schools.

 Bolivia is working to improve teacher training, curriculum development, and access to schools in rural areas.




In 2020, a new, highly-venomous pit viper species, the mountain fer-de-lance, was discovered in the Zongo Valley near La Paz, Bolivia.




