

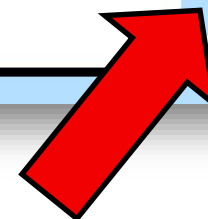

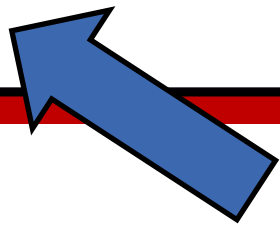
Donald Trump

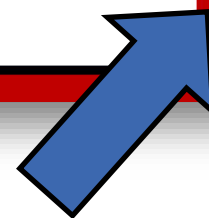

NO PREP NEEDED!

HOW TO PLAY THIS GAME:



1. No prep needed! You can play this game "straight out of the box"!
2. Divide students into teams of 3-4. I usually have the teams move desks so they can confer on answers.
3. Keep score on a whiteboard (teacher or student volunteer), or ask one person on each team to keep track of the scores.

4. Team 1 picks a category and dollar amount. Click the question. If the team answers correctly, they "win" that dollar amount.

5. If Team 1 answers incorrectly, they either get zero points for the question, or (more challenging) they lose the dollar amount.

6. Click "See Question Again" to return to the question. Or, click "Back to Game Board" to return to the game board.
