ABOUT FRIDA

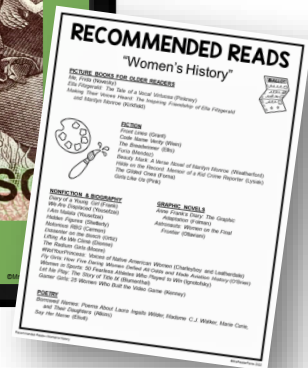
Frida Kahlo was a Mexican painter who was known for her portraits and self-portraits.

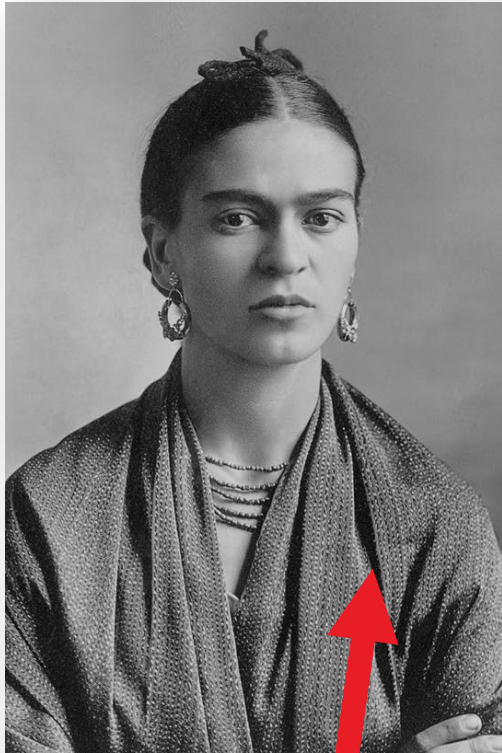


This plane (a Lockheed Vega 5B) was piloted by Amelia Earhart.

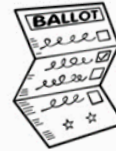




