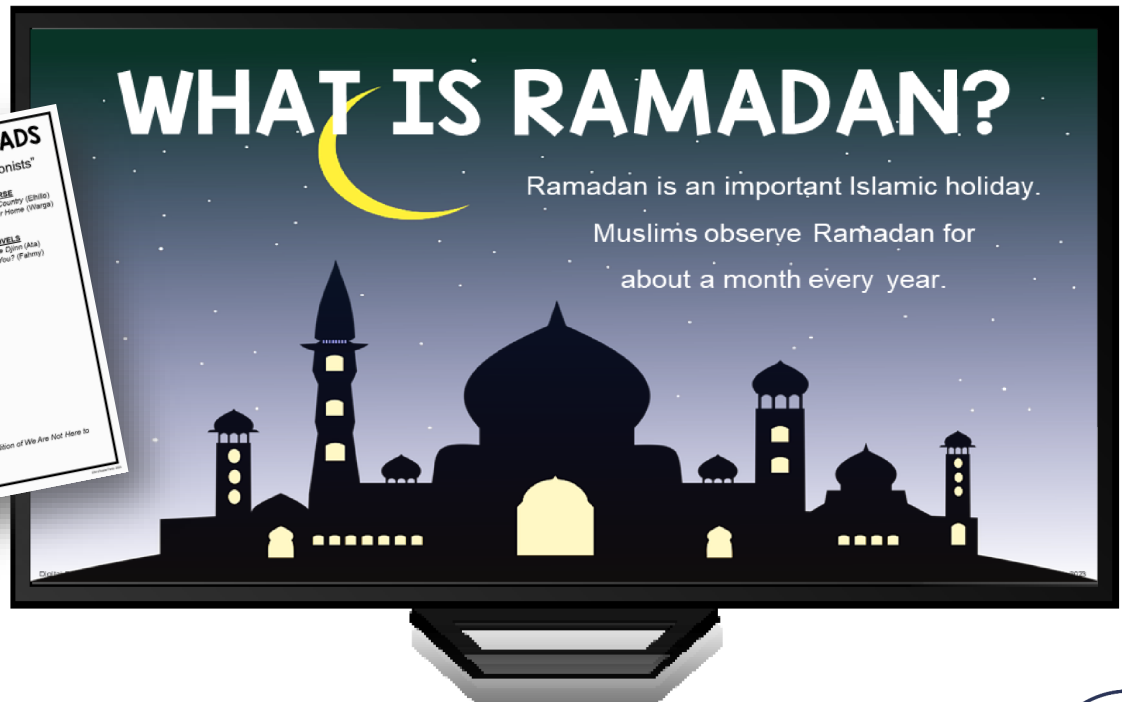
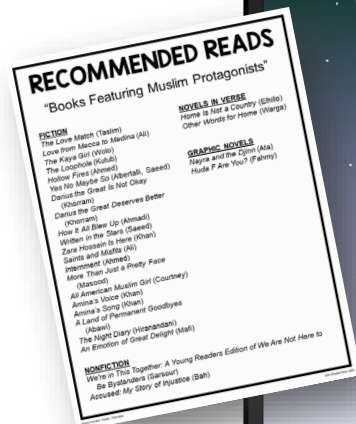

WHAT IS A DIGITAL BULLETIN BOARD?

WHEN IS RAMADAN?

Ramadan is observed in the ninth month of the Islamic calendar. For this reason, the dates of Ramadan change from year to year.

WHAT IS FASTING?

During Ramadan, Muslims do not eat food or drink any liquids—not even water—from sunrise to sunset.

This is called fasting.

THE BLUE MOSQUE

The Blue Mosque is a famous (and very old!) mosque in Tabriz, Iran.



It was built in 1465 and is a major landmark in Iran.

DID YOU KNOW...?

The Muslim call to prayer is called *adhan*. It can be heard five times per day in Muslim communities across the world.

Adhan is broadcast from minarets and through media such as TV and radio.



(noun) A monologue is when a character on stage makes a long, uninterrupted speech.




A monologue is not private and is heard by all characters who are onstage at the time.
