

#### **ANSWER: C - taking photos**

<u>Sunscreen</u> contains chemicals that can damage the reef. Body lotion and hair products can also cause damage. Wear a t-shirt in the water to protect your skin from the sun, and rinse off lotions and hair products before you swim.


