## POLLUTION--\$500

The Great Pacific Garbage Patch is a huge area of trash in the Pacific Ocean. It is twice the size of Texas and growing. $86 \%$ of the trash in the Great Pacific Garbage Patch comes from...

b. plastic straws

## ANSWER: YES!

Humans cannot drink salt water.
We would get very sick and could from drinking too much water from the ocean.

But seabirds, including seagulls, drink saltwater every day! They have special glands that filter the salt from the water.

## PEOPLE--8400

## ANSWER: C - taking photos

Sunscreen contains chemicals that can damage the reef. Body lotion and hair products can also cause damage. Wear a t-shirt in the water to protect your skin from the sun, and rinse off lotions and hair products before you swim.

One person peeing near the coral won't make much difference, but many swimmers peeing in the water can cause problems over time. And never, ever touch the coral! Your skin contains oils that are damaging to the fragile coral.

## NO PREP NEEDED!

## HOW TO PLAY THIS GAME:



1. No prep needed! You can play this game "straight out of the box"!
2. Divide students into $4-5$ teams. I usually have the teams move desks so they can confer on answers.
3. Keep score on a whiteboard (teacher or student volunteer), or ask one person on each team to keep track of the scores.
4. Team 1 picks a category and dollar amount. Click the question. If the team answers correctly, they "win" that dollar amount.
5. If Team 1 answers incorrectly, they lose the dollar amount.
6. Click "Back to Game Board" to return to the game board.
