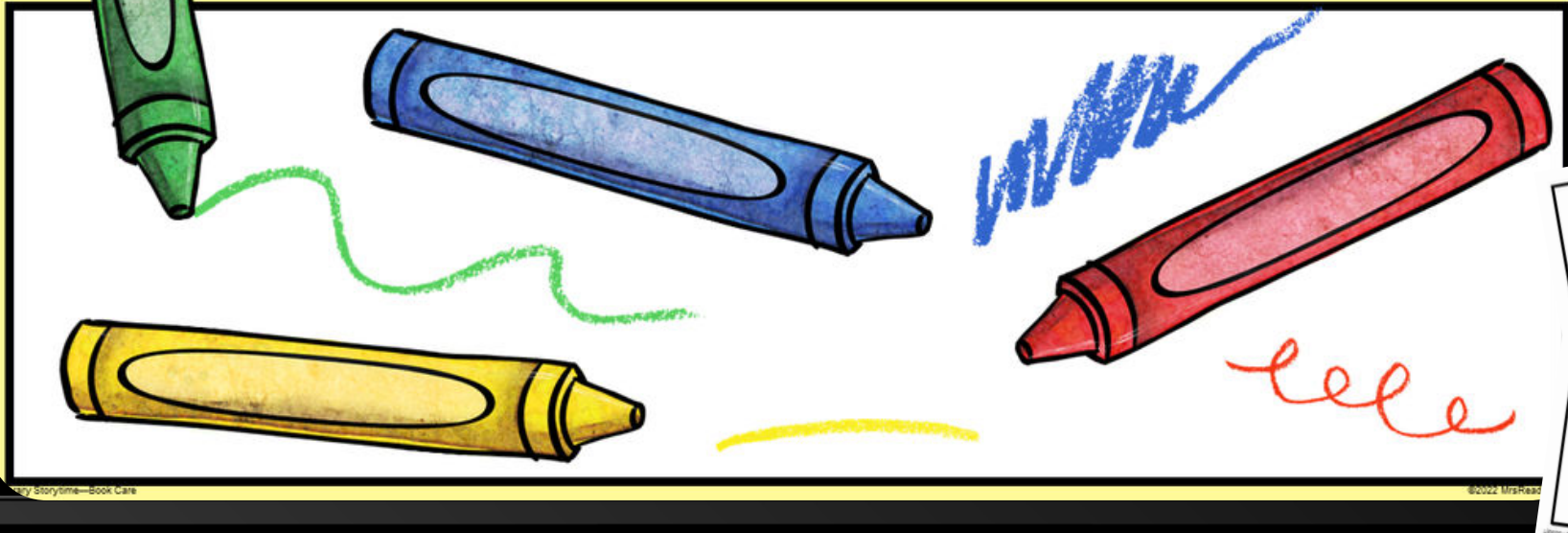

Flexible Year-Long Pacing Guide for Grades K–5

Thank you for your purchase! You now have a full year of flexible library content at your fingertips. I hope this pacing guide makes it faster and easier to turn the bundle's 45 presentations into a cohesive plan for your school year and gives you back some of the evenings and weekends you would otherwise spend preparing lessons.

How to Use This Guide

This bundle was designed for flexibility rather than as a scripted curriculum. The digital bulletin boards, and library lessons into a practical sequence. Choose the calendar needed.

- Choose by grade band. Storytimes generally serve younger students, digital lessons may span several grades. Always use the grade range listed with the presentation.
- Treat a paired theme as one or two instructional weeks, depending on your schedule or library lesson into Parts I and II.
- When a Storytime and Digital Bulletin Board share a theme, use the Storytime presentation.
- Add a read-aloud when needed. Digital bulletin boards do not include a checkout activity of your choice.
- Extend freely. Most resources can fill one or two 50-minute library sessions, holidays, field trips, school closures, and lessons that run long.
- Move date-sensitive lessons every year. Ramadan and Lunar New Year holidays may also require adjustments.

Pacing Guide A: Mid-August Start

One suggested theme per instructional library week. Seasonal timing is approximate; adjust to your district calendar.

1	Mid-Aug.	Back to School ST (K–2)	Back to School DBB #1 (3–6)	Welcome, procedures, and library expectations.
2	August	Book Care ST (K–3)	Back to School DBB #2 (3–6) + book-care review	Use the DBB during checkout; add a brief review for older students.
3	August	Parts of a Book ST (K–2)	Back to School DBB #3 (3–6) + parts-of-a-book review	Evergreen skill week.
4	Early Sept.	Friendship ST (K–3)	Back to School DBB #4 (3–6) + friendship read-aloud	A flexible community-building theme.
5	Grandparents Day	Grandparents Day ST (K–3)	Grandparents Day DBB (3–6)	Place near Grandparents Day if your school observes it.
6	Mid-Sept.	Mexico ST (K–2)	Mexico DBB (3–6)	Fits Hispanic Heritage Month or another Mexico study.
7	Late Sept.	Autumn ST (K–3)	Autumn DBB (3–6); Football DBB (4–7) optional	Football can run during checkout at any point in the fall.
8	Early Oct.	Media Literacy ST (K–3)	News Media DBB (3–6)	Pair the DBB with discussion or a related read-aloud.
9	October	Fiction and Nonfiction ST (K–2)	Nonfiction DBB (3–7)	Evergreen lesson placed before the holiday-heavy weeks.
10	Mid-Oct.	Halloween ST (K–2)	Halloween DBB (3–6)	Move earlier if your calendar has a late-October break.
11	Late Oct.	Spider ST (K–3)	Halloween DBB extension + spider read-aloud	The DBB may continue scrolling during checkout.
12	Late Oct.	Superstitions ST (K–3)	Halloween DBB extension + superstition discussion	Another flexible choice for the week before Halloween.
13	Election week	USA Election Day ST (K–3)	USA Elections DBB (3–6)	Use in election years or as a general civic-learning theme.
14	Early Nov.	Veterans Day LL (K–5)	Veterans Day LL (K–5)	Schedule before or during Veterans Day week.
15	Late Nov.	Thanksgiving LL (K–5)	Thanksgiving LL (K–5)	Use before the Thanksgiving break.
16	Early Dec.	Nursery Rhymes ST (K–3)	Supplement: wordplay or folklore read-aloud	Evergreen buffer before winter holidays.
17	Mid-Dec.	December Holidays LL (2–5); supplement for K–1	December Holidays LL (2–5)	Adjust to your district calendar and community.
18	Early Jan.	Snow & Ice LL (K–5)	Snow & Ice LL (K–5)	Seasonal, but not tied to a specific holiday.
19	MLK Day	Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day LL (2–5); supplement for K–1	Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day LL (2–5)	

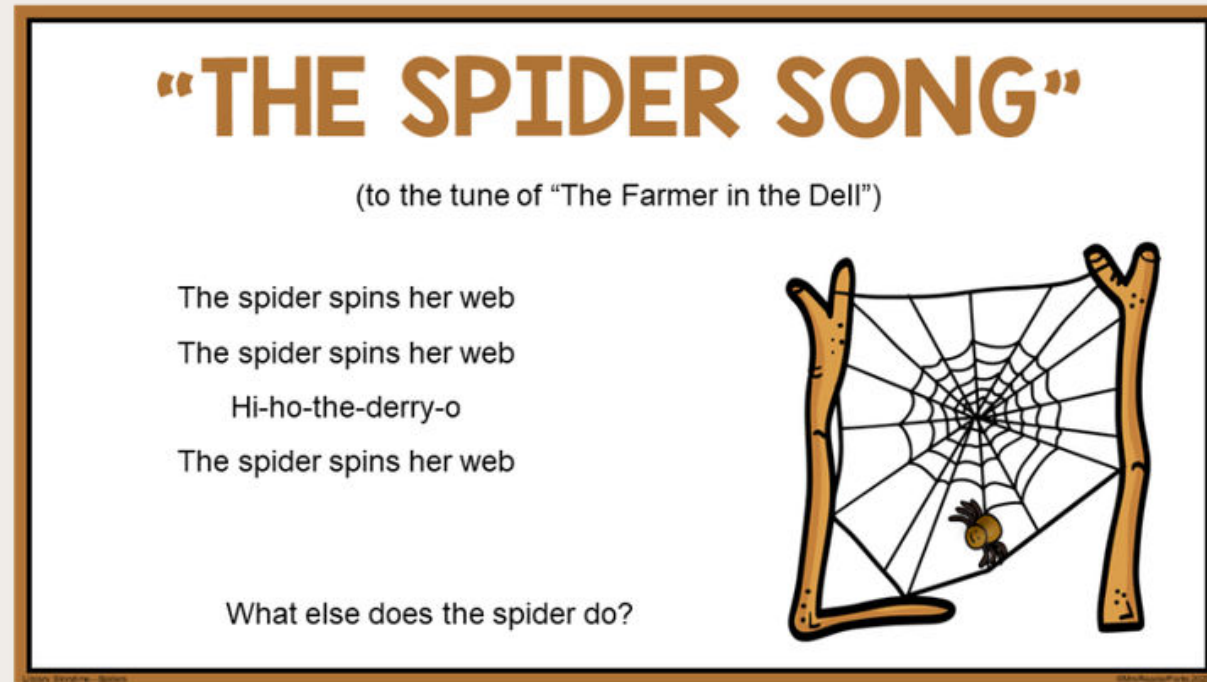
Pacing Guide B: Start After Labor Day

A condensed opening sequence for schools beginning in early September. Passive displays may overlap while direct lessons remain one week.

Week	Month / window	Grades K–2	Grades 3–5	Planning note
1	After Labor Day	Back to School ST (K–2)	Back to School DBBs #1–2 (3–6)	Rotate the two DBBs during checkout.
2	Early Sept.	Book Care ST (K–3)	Back to School DBB #3 (3–6) + book-care review	Condensed start-of-year procedures.
3	Grandparents Day	Grandparents Day ST (K–3)	Grandparents Day DBB (3–6); Back to School DBB #4 optional	Move this week if your observance falls earlier.
4	Mid-Sept.	Parts of a Book ST (K–2)	Mexico DBB (3–6)	Different grade bands may use different themes this week.
5	Late Sept.	Mexico ST (K–2)	Autumn DBB (3–6); Football DBB (4–7) optional	Use Mexico during Hispanic Heritage Month; football can run anytime in fall.
6	Early Oct.	Autumn ST (K–3)	News Media DBB (3–6)	Pair upper grades with discussion or a read-aloud.
7	October	Media Literacy ST (K–3)	Nonfiction DBB (3–7)	A flexible information-literacy week.
8	Late Oct.	Halloween ST (K–2)	Halloween DBB (3–6)	Schedule before Halloween.
9	Early Nov.	Spider ST (K–3)	Halloween DBB extension + spider read-aloud	Extend the Halloween DBB during checkout.
10	Mid-Nov.	Superstitions ST (K–3)	USA Election Day ST (K–3)	Use in election years or as a general civic-learning theme.
