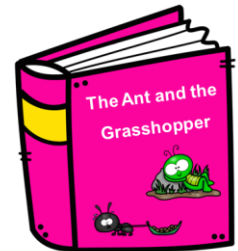
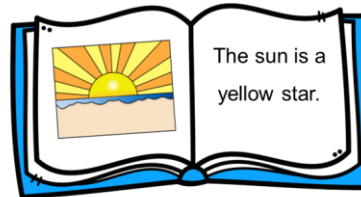
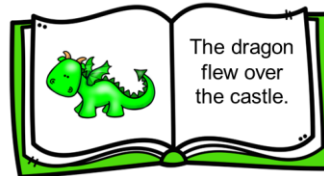


NONFICTION BOOKS
