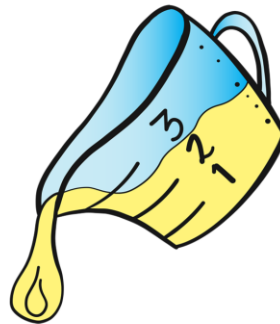

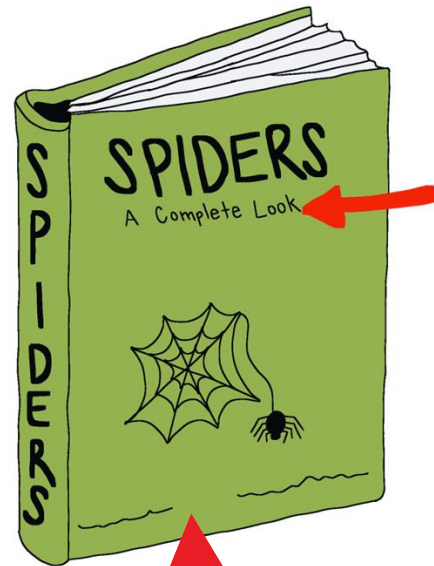

TEXT FEATURE: SUBTITLE

- Shorter text that adds more information about the title
- This subtitle tells you that this book about spiders has lots of information about many different aspects of spiders.
- When writing it out, the subtitle should follow a colon, like this:
 - *Spiders: A Complete Look*
