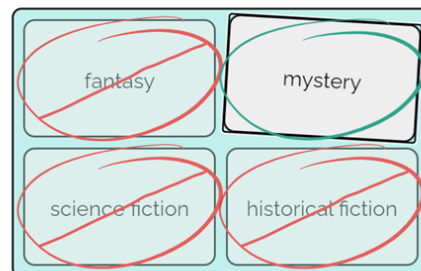

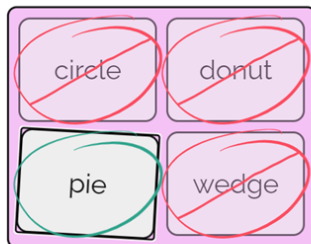

Yes, as long as students have an internet connection and a device, they can access the BOOM™ Cards anytime they like.

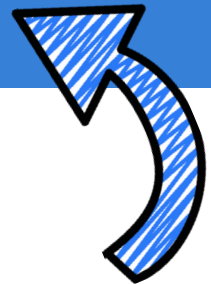
## Can I leave BOOM™ Cards for a sub?

4. Click the "Classes" tab → Click "+" → Click "Add Students"
5. Back in your "Library," click "Assign."

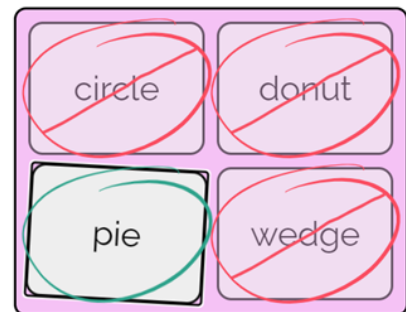

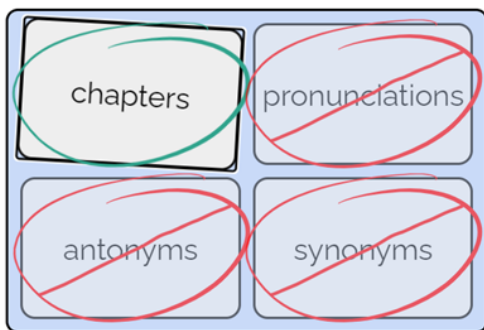

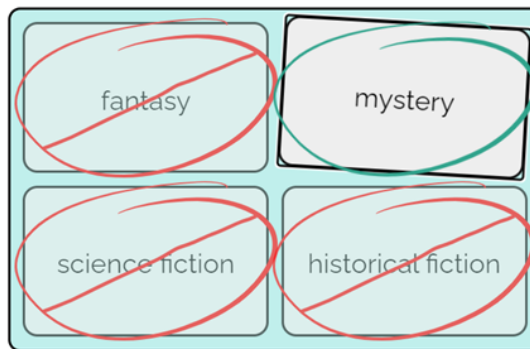

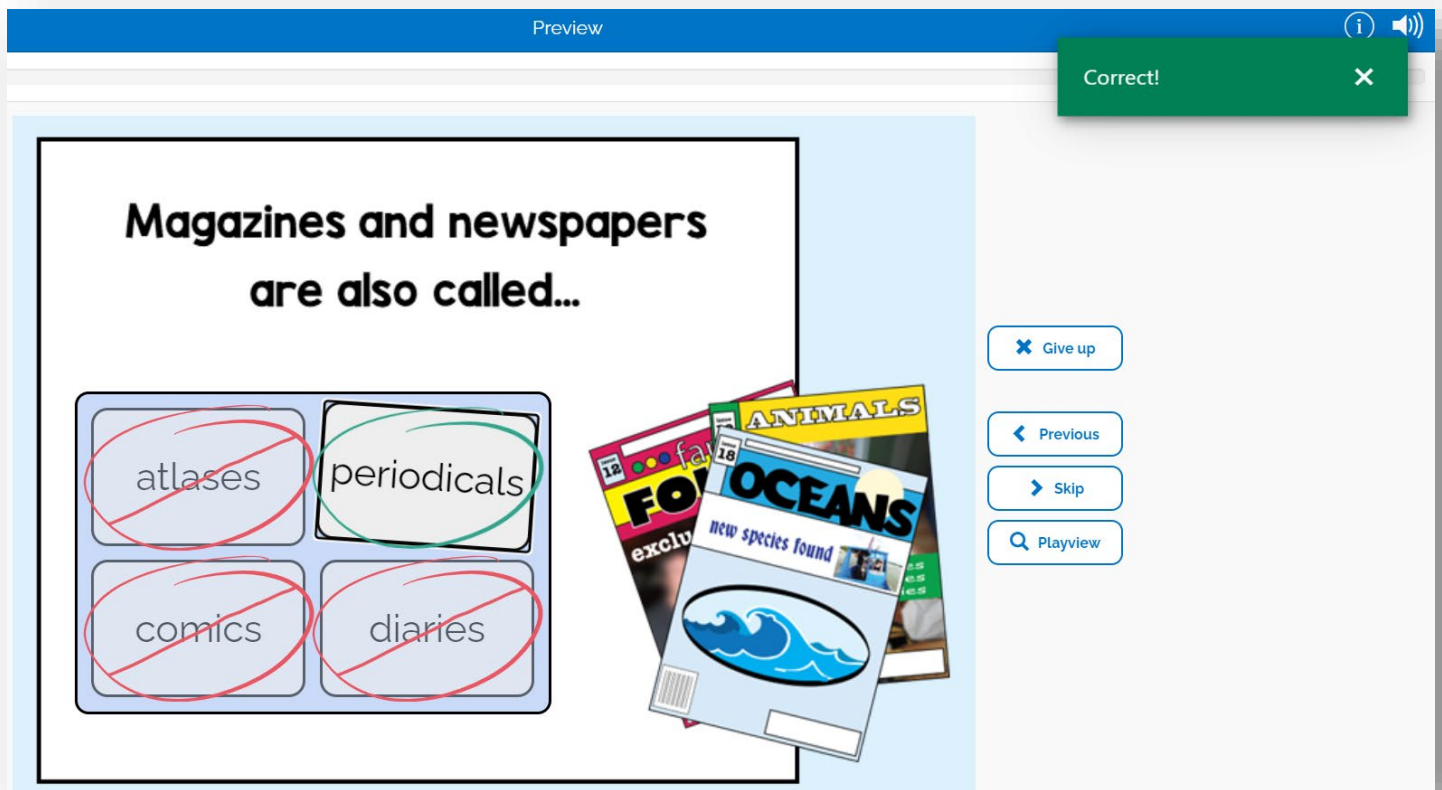

They also make a special “incorrect” noise.

Correct answers show green when clicked. They make a short bell noise to indicate they are correct.

Students can choose as many answers as they need.  
They can also skip cards if needed.
