




# 1900 Galveston Hurricane

Well over 100 years later, the Galveston Hurricane is still the most devastating hurricane in US history.

There were between 8000-12,000 deaths. The highest sustained windspeed was 145 mph, which made it a Category 4 hurricane.







Cards 16-23 are <u>brown</u> cards. These are about Texas plant and animal life. Includes Austin bats, red yucca, prickly pear, coyotes, armadillos, Caddo Lake trees, and longhorn steers. One card includes additional information (above).



Cards 24-30 are <u>blue</u> cards. These are about travel and landmarks. Includes The Alamo, Austin landmarks, Johnson Space Center, the Fort Worth Stockyards, and number of hours it takes to travel across Texas. Includes two informational cards.
