




BIODIVERSITY

- Honduras is part of the Mesoamerican Biodiversity Hotspot. Lots of diverse plants and animals in Honduras and throughout Central America!
- · Lots of insects, birds, and reptiles
- Lots of butterflies, beetles, moths, spiders, mosquitoes, flies, bees—many are brightly colored
- Crocodiles, snakes, lizards, iguanas, turtles
- Deer, tapirs, pumas, jaguars, ocelots, monkeys
- Some protected national parks and rainforests

Belize

- · 66 miles of thick forests, mountains, and rivers along the Panama and Colombia border
- · One of world's most dangerous migration routes



Panama

- Very difficult to go through this area every year, refugees from South America die trying to pass through
- Pan American Highway runs from Alaska to the southern tip of South America – the only place it breaks up is in the Darién Gap
- Dangers include mudslides, swift rivers, flash flooding, crime, no safe

NACATAMALES

Nacatamales are a special dish from Nicaragua that people usually eat on weekends and important events.

They look like little packages wrapped in banana leaves, but you can't eat the leaves!

Inside, there's a mixture of corn dough with vegetables, spices, rice, and meat that makes it super tasty.

It takes two whole days to make, and it's important to follow the recipe steps very carefully to get it just right.






Guatemala

CLIMATE

- Much of Guatemala is mountainous and cool
- Tropical climate near coasts
- Rainy season (May-Oct) and dry season (Nov-April)
- Earthquakes, volcanoes, and hurricanes
- · Hurricanes are a serious problem; cause lots of devastation, especially in very poor areas




