





Students play a shark "Fact or Fiction?" game. Students thumbs-up if they think the statement is fact and thumbs-down if they think the statement is fiction.


PART II SCROLLING SLIDES

Part III is great for the end of library time. Use these 6 slides to select students for line-up, to keep students engaged while waiting in line for their teacher, or as a time filler as needed.


