Holi is a Hindu spring festival, also known as the Festival of Colors.

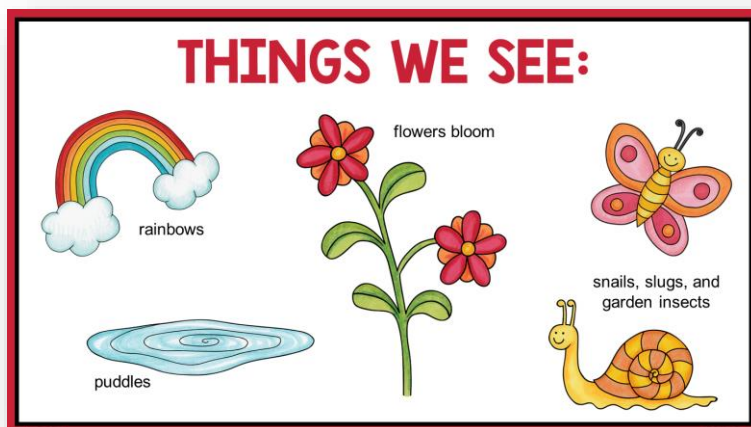
During Holi, people throw and smear colored powders and water. People playfully chase each other with these colors. It is a fun celebration!
