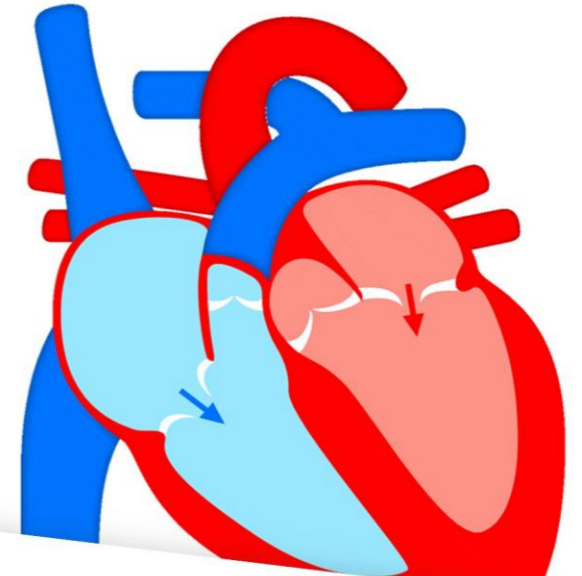

Cardi- comes from the Greek word *kardia*, which means heart.



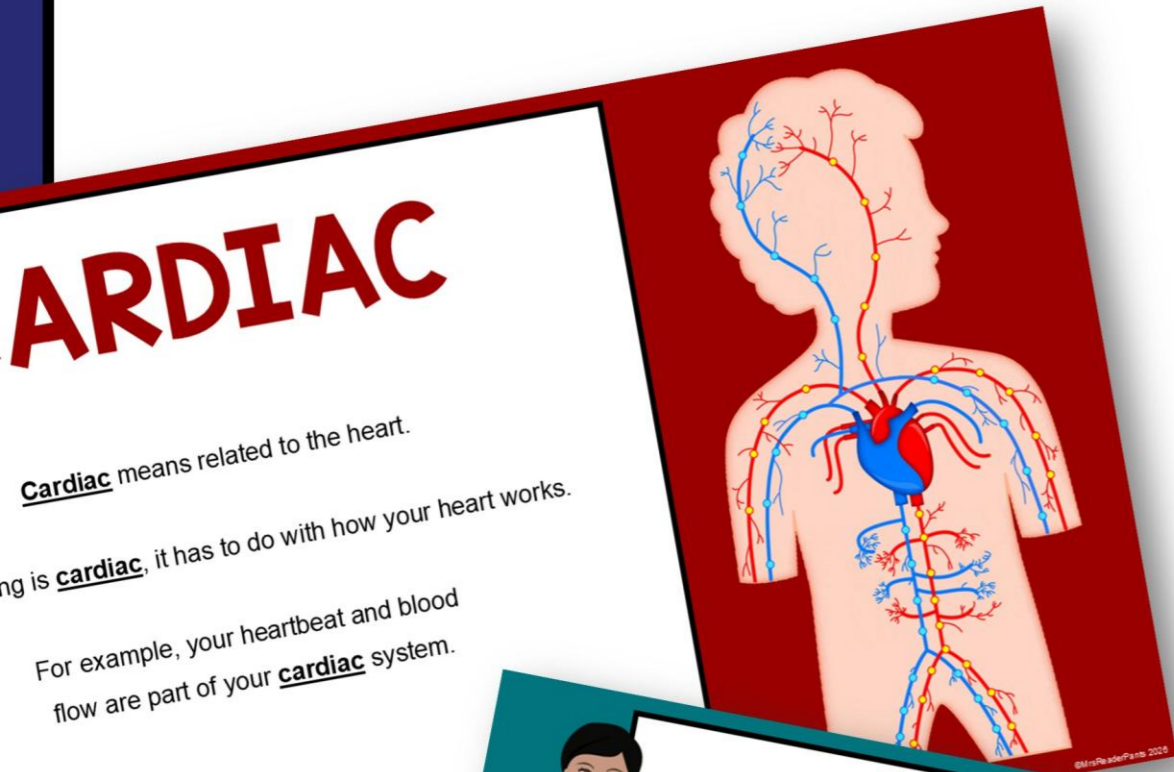

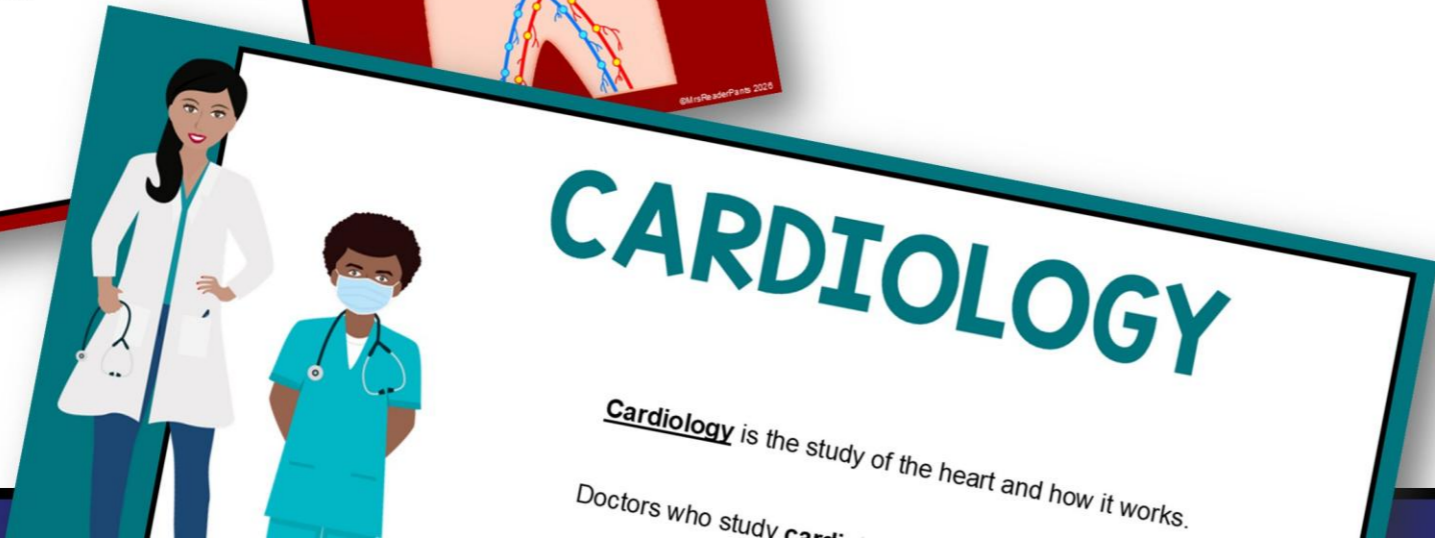

Dependent clause = subordinating conjunction + subject + verb



Complex Sentences

- Complex sentences contain **one independent** clause and **one or more dependent** clauses.
- If the dependent clause is first, you need to separate it with a comma.
- If the dependent clause is after the independent clause, a comma is not needed.

Examples:
My internet keeps going out because it's windy outside, my internet is not working.
